COMMITTEE THE 907 PASSENGERS OF STLOUIS DANGLING FOR LAST THIRTEEN
DAYS BETWEEN HOPE AND DESPAIR RECEIVED TODAY YOUR LIBERATING
MESSAGE OF THE 13 JUNE THAT FINAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR ALL PASSENGERS
HAVE AT LAST BEEN REACHED OUR GRATITUDE IS AS IMMENSE AS THE
OCEAN ON WHICH WE ARE NOW FLOATING SINCE MAY 13 FIRST FULL OF
HOPE FOR A GOOD FUTURE AND AFTERWARDS IN THE DEEPEST DESPAIR
STOP ACCEPT MR. CHAIRMAN FOR YOU AND FOR THE AMERICAN JOINT
DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE AND LAST BUT NOT LEAST FOR THE GOVERNMENTS
OF BELGIUM HOLLAND FRANCE AND ENGLAND THE DEEPEST AND ETERNAL THANKS
OF MEN WOMEN AND CHILDREN UNITED BY THE SAME FATE ON BOARD THE
STLOUIS SIGNED COMMITTEE OF PASSENGERS JOSEPH UNQUOTE THE STLOUIS
WILL ARRIVE IN ANTWERP WHERE ALL PASSENGERS WILL DISEMBARK
SATURDAY AFTERNOON STOP AM PERSONALLY FLYING TOMORROW FRIDAY
MORNING TO ANTWERP ORDER MAKE ALL PRELIMINARY ARRANGEMENTS STOP
AM ADVISED BELGIAN RED CROSS WILL MEET STLOUIS ANTWERP SPECIAL
TENDERS WILL TAKE PASSENGERS FOR HOLLAND FRANCE ENGLAND THOSE
